• Vendor information.

There are a several good sources for LaserWriter adhesive media:

Avery (labels, paper, transparencies)
Chart Pack (Drafting Applique Film)
Dennison (labels, paper, transparencies)
James River Corporation (labels, paper, transparencies)

To locate a vendor's address and phone numbers, use the vendor name as a search string.

Note: The LaserWriter II's straight paper cassette path will accommodate labels. However, it is still best to use the manual feed guide on a LaserWriter or LaserWriter Plus. The two main reasons are:

- 1. Label stock is too thick for the paper cassette.
- 2. The cassette itself could separate the protective backing from the paper, which could then stick to a roller and wind around it.
