Macintosh Portable: TCP/Connect & NCSA Telnet Compatibility

TOPIC -----

I recently read that versions of NCSA Telnet, including NCSA Telnet 2.3 and the current version of TCP/Connect, do not work with the Macintosh Portable.

Is this a MacTCP (driver) problem or is it purely application-based? Should TCP/Connect II offer a solution?

DISCUSSION -----

The incompatibility is with the applications, not with MacTCP. InterCon told us that the latest version of TCP/Connect (version 1.0.1) does work properly with the Macintosh Portable. As of November, NCSA was preparing version 2.4 of NCSA Telnet. Version 2.4 will work with the Macintosh Portable. For more information, please contact: NCSA and InterCon Corp.
