What does the DRAM expansion kit do when it is added to the Macintosh Display Card 8.24 GC? How does more DRAM affect the image capture capabilities of the display card?

DISCUSSION -----

When you add the DRAM expansion kit it allows the Macintosh Display Card $8 \cdot 24$ GC to boost the performance of applications that use off-screen bitmaps and other graphics techniques. This way, when you scroll a picture through a window, more of it has already been drawn and the image scrolls without jittering.
