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A/UX: Changing the Default Editor (9/94)

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TOPIC -----

Under A/UX, is it possible to change the default editor from TeachText to something else?

DISCUSSION -----

If you wish to change the default editor, change the environment variable `FINDER_EDITOR`. You'll need to change this in either the `.login` file for `cs`h users -- or `.profile` for `korn` or `bourne` shell users.

As an example for C shell users add a new line to the bottom of the `.login` file as follows:

```
setenv FINDER_EDITOR <editorpathname>
setenv FINDER_EDITOR /mac/bin/TextEdit -for TextEditor
setenv FINDER_EDITOR /usr/bin/vi -for vi"
```
