TOPIC -----

I have a Macintosh LC with the Apple IIe Card connected to Ethernet via a SCSI Ethernet box. Can I use ProDOS software to access AppleTalk services?

DISCUSSION -----

Our driver is designed to use the Apple Ethernet LC Card and not to look for the Ethernet connection from the SCSI port. If the vendor of the SCSI Ethernet box included a driver for the Apple IIe Card side, that setup should work.

We suggest that you contact the vendor of the SCSI Ethernet box for confirmation.
