TOPIC -----

I have a Macintosh LC, running system software version 6.0.7, and a StyleWriter printer. At startup, the TrueType INIT is scrambled.

I trashed the System Folder, reinstalled the version 6.0.7 system software, and removed all other INITs. I also ran Disinfectant 2.4 and rebuilt the desktop, but I am still having the problem.

DISCUSSION -----

Since we haven't had other reports of this problem, we suspect that your version of TrueType is corrupted. Try installing TrueType from another known-good disk.
