What is the line screen number (lines per inch) for the LaserWriter IIf and LaserWriter IIg? It was 53 on an LaserWriter IINTX.

DISCUSSION -----

With PhotoGrade off, the LaserWriter IIf and LaserWriter IIg are just like the LaserWriter IINTX:

Frequency: 53 lpi
Screen Angle: 45 degrees

With PhotoGrade on, there are five settings available via the LaserWriter Utility. Here are the numbers:

Far right:	Frequency: 150 lpi; Screen Angle: 0 degrees
Middle right:	Frequency: 106 lpi; Screen Angle: 45 degrees
Center:	Frequency: 83 lpi; Screen Angle: 56 degrees
Middle left:	Frequency: 75 lpi; Screen Angle: 0 degrees
Far Left:	Frequency: 53 lpi; Screen Angle: 45 degrees

Note: The "Middle right" setting is the default PhotoGrade setting.
