TOPIC -----

I installed the Security Zone zone name on a spare port of one of our MaxWay 500s, and it shows up in the Chooser.

Unfortunately, it doesn't seem to have any effect. When I click on "Answer calls" in the Remote Access Setup CDEV, it doesn't ask for password -- even if I click on "entire network."

DISCUSSION -----

The problem probably stems from the following:

When you run the Security Zone stack, it displays the name you should give to the Security Zone. Unless the name is printed, the stack only displays 15 characters of the 16-character password. You probably have a 15-character password. Therefore, the AppleTalk Remote Access program isn't treating it as a true Security Zone. Try re-entering the zone name with the full name from the stack.
