DISCUSSION -----

The LaserWriter IINT is Apple's mainstream network laser printer, ideal for producing sophisticated text and graphics. The LaserWriter IINT features a 68000 microprocessor, providing fast 300 dpi output. It also offers 2MB of RAM and 1MB of ROM, allowing you to store a wide variety of fonts. Eleven font families (35 typefaces) are included with the LaserWriter IINT.

The LaserWriter IINT features built-in support for the AppleTalk Personal Network, allowing up to 31 users to share the printer. The LaserWriter IINT works with any software that outputs PostScript-compatible files, offering unlimited flexibility in creating and manipulating text and graphics.

An RS-232 port provides easy connection to MS-DOS computers. The LaserWriter IINT supports the Diablo 630 Emulation Mode. MS-DOS users can access the printer by purchasing an AppleTalk PC Card or the appropriate RS-232 cable.

The LaserWriter IINT is compatible with Macintosh Plus, Macintosh SE, Macintosh II, and Apple IIGS, as well as the Apple LaserShare Print Spooler.
