This article describes the LaserWriter IISC.

DISCUSSION -----

The LaserWriter IISC is Apple's entry-level, single-user laser printer. It brings the individual Macintosh user full-page, high-resolution text and graphics.

The LaserWriter IISC features a 68000 microprocessor providing high-speed performance. A SCSI interface provides high-speed data transfer for faster printing.

Because it relies on QuickDraw in the Macintosh -- instead of PostScript -- to process documents, there are no fonts resident in the LaserWriter IISC.

The LaserWriter IISC is compatible with the Macintosh Plus, Macintosh SE, and Macintosh II computers, and connects through a SCSI port.
