TOPIC -----

Can I use the IIci Cache Card in the new Accelerator slot?

DISCUSSION -----

No. The Macintosh IIci Cache Card is incompatible with the new accelerator slot. The accelerator slot does not accommodate cache-only cards.

Macintosh IIvx has its cache architecture on the logic board, which means the accelerator slot is left open for a third-party accelerator card.

Accelerator cards such as 50 MHz 68030s or cards based on 68040s are meant for this slot.
