TOPIC -----

I just upgraded to System 7.1. I'm using Adobe Type Manager, and the on-screen fonts are not smooth.

DISCUSSION -----

Contact Adobe for a free upgrade to the latest version of ATM. In the meantime, if you're using ATM, you must move any PostScript printer fonts located in the Font folder to the Extensions folder. After you upgrade to the new version of ATM, these fonts will work correctly when placed in the Font folder.

Adobe is offering Apple computer owners a free copy of their latest ATM software. With ATM, you'll gain access to thousands of PostScript Type 1 fonts for use on-screen. ATM software can be used with all Macintosh-supported printers, including the ImageWriter, StyleWriter, and PostScript typesetters.

Adobe is including four typefaces from the Adobe Garamond family with this offer. Adobe is charging only a minimal shipping and handling charge for this software for U.S. and Canadian residents. Orders outside the U.S. and Canada carry a larger shipping and handling charge.
