This article provides ordering information for System 7.1 Upgrade Kits.

DISCUSSION -----

System 7.1 is available in three kits.

For Users Upgrading from System 6.0.X

- The System 7.1 Personal Upgrade Kit (M7200LL/A) contains the software you need to upgrade from System 6.0.X to System 7.1 on a single Macintosh.
- The System 7.1 MultiPack (M7201LL/A) contains the software you need to upgrade from System 6.0.X to System 7.1 for up to 10 Macintosh computers.

The MultiPack provides a set of system enablers. The Personal Upgrade Kit and MultiPack Kit come with a new Compatibility Checker that doesn't require the HyperCard application.

The Personal Upgrade kit and the MultiPack are available through your local dealer.

For Users Upgrading from System 7.0 or 7.0.1

- The 7.1 Update Kit (M7201LL/A) contains the software you need to upgrade from System 7.0 or 7.0.1 to System 7.1 on a single Macintosh.
