TOPIC -----

How does Apple measure the Macintosh Color Display?

DISCUSSION -----

The Macintosh Color Display measures approximately 14 inches from corner to corner of the CRT (with the front bezel removed). This is the industry-standard method of measuring displays, and all display vendors call this CRT size a 14" display.

Apple formerly measured its displays from inside corner to inside corner of the front bezel. By this measurement, the Macintosh Color Display and the previous AppleColor High-Resolution RGB Display measure approximately 13".
