System 7: Spooling Options and Print Server Options

TOPIC -----

Are there any alternatives to PrintMonitor and/or the AppleShare print server?

DISCUSSION -----

Yes. SuperLaserSpool from 5th Generation Systems will do background printing to LaserWriters and all the ImageWriters and HP LaserJets, DeskJets and DeskWriters. It also includes the desk accessory, LaserQueue, that lets you preview and prioritize documents, re-route them to other printers, or print to several printers simultaneously.

Print Central is an "enhanced" Print Server from Compumation Inc. It includes printer load balancing, an authorized user list, remote status and control, and redirection of print jobs to other printers. They also have an enhanced Print Central called Color Central. Color Central allows you to use low-resolution art files in your documents, but print corresponding high-resolution graphics that are stored on the server.

Blue Parrot from Casa Blanca Works Inc. is a control panel that displays the print queue for any networked printer in your zone. For it to work effectively, all Macintosh computers that print must run copies of the program.
