TOPIC -----

Can I spool print jobs (using Print Monitor) and hold them for printing at a later time?

DISCUSSION -----

Yes. Before printing, open Print Monitor by double-clicking on the application (in the Extensions folder). When it's open, select "stop printing" from the File menu. Leave the window open and print the jobs you want. They will line up in the window. When you want to send them to the printer, just select "resume printing" from the file menu or select each job and set a print time, then select "resume printing."
