AppleTalk Remote Access Through a Secure ID System

TOPIC -----

I am using a "Secure ID" system for anyone trying to connect to the internal network system. This "Secure ID" system uses a "credit card" interface with uniquely assigned user passwords each time someone connects to the network. Currently this is only available for terminal emulation.

I would like to know if there is a way for remote network access with our Macintoshes using ARA through this Secure ID system? Has anyone written a CCL to access this system?

DISCUSSION -----

The only vendor that currently offers Secure ID access via ARA is Cayman Systems. The Cayman System GatorLink, 3 port ARA server offers an optional Secure ID server module which can be used with a Secure ID server. Contact Cayman Systems and Security Dynamics for more information.
