

System 7: Rescued Items Folder Appears in the Trash 1/93

The Rescued Items Folder is created any time a System 7 Macintosh starts up with items in the Temporary Folder. These items are then moved from the Temporary Folder to the Rescued Items Folder in the Trash so the user can inspect them.

The Temporary Folder is a folder that sits at the root level of a drive and is invisible to the user. Applications can use it for any purpose. Typically, this includes scratch files or temporary data files.
