TOPIC -----

I have a site running DAL for SUN OS using Oracle6.

My Question is how can I tell DAL to use another Instance of Oracle? I have tried changing the Oracle SID in the .LOCAL & .CSHRC file for the username without any change. SQLplus recognizes the change in SID, but DAL continues to use the old SID.

DISCUSSION -----

Check the .PROFILE for the user on the second Oracle to verify that you have the correct paths. This is the file used by interactive processes, which SQLPlus is not. The .PROFILE has to be changed to point to the desired installation of the Oracle SID.
