TOPIC -----

How do I control a LaserWriter Pro's print density from MS-DOS or Windows?

DISCUSSION -----

The only way to control the LaserWriter Pro's print density from MS-DOS or Windows is to download PostScript code directly to the printer. You can find the parameters in the LaserWriter Pro Developer's Notes (available from APDA) and then send the PostScript code to the printer with the LaserWriter Utility.

Note that you will see very little difference when you change the LaserWriter Pro's print density. The difference is small, and is about the same as the print density setting on the LaserWriter II printers.
