DISCUSSION	

With the MacX 1.2 Update product, you receive the following items:

- MacX 1.2 Release Notes
- MacX 1.1.7 Release Notes
- MacTCP Administrator's Guide, version 1.1
- MacX Application disk
- MacX Communications disk
- Communications 1 disk
- Network Products Installer disk

To update to MacX 1.2, perform these steps:

• Install the MacX 1.2 application program, located on the MacX Application disk.

If you're not using A/UX, go to Chapter 2, "Installing MacX," of the MacX Installation Guide. Follow the instructions that apply to your Macintosh computer's hardware and software configuration. You do not have to reinstall the other files on the MacX Application disk (MacX Colors file, Sample, and so on).

- A/UX users: Replace your version of MacX with the one on your new MacX Application disk. Unless you've moved your MacX program, you'll find it in the /mac/MacX/ directory. As soon as you replace the program, you can begin using it. If you don't have permissions to

access this directory, see your system administrator.

• If you're not using A/UX, install the MacTCP 1.1.1 driver located on the MacX Communications disk.

Go to the MacTCP Connection Tool Module in the MacX Binder. Follow the instructions that apply to your Macintosh computer's hardware and software configuration to install and configure MacTCP 1.1.1.

- A/UX users: The version of MacTCP that resides in your Control Panels folder is customized for A/UX only. Do not use the MacTCP 1.1.1 driver that's included on the MacX 1.2 Communications disk. MacTCP 1.1.1 supports the Macintosh Operating System only, not A/UX.

The Communications 1 disk and the Network Products Installer disk are included in your MacX 1.2 Update product in the unlikely event that you need to reinstall the Communications Toolbox on your computer. Read Chapter 3, "Setting Up Communications," in the MacX Installation Guide for instructions about installing the Communications Toolbox on system software version 6.0.5, 6.0.6, or 6.0.7. If you're using version 7.0 or later, or you're using A/UX, you don't need to install the Communications Toolbox; it is built into system software versions 7.0 and later.
