TOPIC -----

What happens with At Ease when I start up with the Shift key down?

DISCUSSION -----

At Ease always loads, but if there's no password or the proper password is entered, At Ease quits and the Finder loads. In the Finder, At Ease won't be available under the Application menu. Here's the startup sequence with the Shift key down:

- 1) System software loads.
- 2) Extensions don't load.
- 3) At Ease loads.
- 4) At Ease checks for a password and asks for the password if one is installed.
- 5) At Ease quits.
- 6) Finder loads.

If you click the Cancel button when At Ease asks for the password, At Ease loads as normal and displays its menus and panels. You still find the password enabled if you go to the Finder. From the Finder, At Ease is available under the Application menu.
