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Apple Workgroup Server 95: Installer Tips (5/93)

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TOPIC -----

This article describes Apple Workgroup Server (AWS) 95 installer tips.

DISCUSSION -----

Software comes pre-installed, however, customers may wish to add new disk drives to the system, re-configure the installation, or re-install in the event of corrupted software. All software for the AWS 95 is included on one CD-ROM. Therefore a CD-ROM drive is needed for installation. Furthermore, it must be an Apple CD-ROM drive or other CD-ROM drive compatible with A/UX.

By default, the A/UX system that is pre-installed or that is installed when the "Easy Install" option is chosen is a minimal A/UX system. This configuration does not include some UNIX utilities, NFS, compilers, and so on. To install the extra parts of A/UX you must launch the installer and use the Custom Install option.

To perform an installation, simply insert the boot floppy disk into the floppy disk drive, insert the installation CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive, and power on the machine. The AWS 95 will automatically bring up the Easy Install screen.

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
