DISCUSSION	
To add AppleSha	are volumes to the AWS 95, you need to do the

- 1) Install AppleShare Pro on the AWS 95.
- 2) Physically install the new disk drive. Remember that for best performance, drives should be attached to a SCSI chain on the PDS card.
- 3) After restarting A/UX, start up the Apple HD SC Setup program located in the Applications folder on the "/" drive.
- 4) Select both the SCSI bus number and the SCSI id of the new drive, then click the Initialize button.
- 5) When done initializing the disk, click on Partition. Select "File Server Data" for the partitioning scheme. Enter the number of equal partitions you want on the disk (from 1 to 12). This will create UNIX file systems, rather than HFS file systems, which are recommended for better performance.
- 6) Create a mount point for each partition. This is a unique name for each partition. By default, the mount points are located under "/ Shared Data".
- 7) After creating a mount point for each partition, click Quit to return to the Finder.
