TOPIC -----

If you use the AudioVision 14 Display with other devices that include software, such as the Apple Adjustable Keyboard or third-party ADB devices, install the AudioVision software LAST.

DISCUSSION -----

Software for some other devices may overwrite your monitor software. For example, if you install software for the Apple Adjustable Keyboard after installing software for the AudioVision 14 Display, the keyboard's Sound control panel may replace the monitor's Sound control panel. The result is that you lose the AudioVision "Volumes" Sound control panel.

Also, with the Apple Adjustable Keyboard, follow these steps after you install the software:

- 1) Follow the instructions to restart
- 2) Turn off the computer and monitor
- 3) Wait 30 seconds before powering up.

If you don't follow these steps, the display won't be recognized.
