TOPIC -----

What software do I install if I want to use the Apple AudioVision 14 Display and Apple Adjustable Keyboard with the Macintosh Centris 660AV, Quadra 660AV or Quadra 840AV?

DISCUSSION -----

If you use both the Apple Adjustable Keyboard and the Apple AudioVision 14 Display with your computer, do not install the software supplied with the Apple Adjustable Keyboard. This software is already installed on your Macintosh Centris 660AV and Quadra 840AV computer.

To use this keyboard and this monitor with your computer, install only the software for the AudioVision 14 Display. (The reason for not installing the keyboard software is that it overwrites some necessary software for the monitor.)

If you have already installed the keyboard software, you should reinstall the Macintosh system software (included with your computer, on floppy disks or on a compact disc) to restore the files you need.
