TOPIC -----

I'm using At Ease 1.x in a laboratory of computers containing a file server. When a student clicks on a button in At Ease for an item located on the file server, a message prompts to log in. If the user account doesn't have access privileges to the item, an error will appear that the alias can't be opened, because the original item can't be found. The button is then removed from the At Ease screen. The administrator then has to go back into At Ease and set the button up again.

DISCUSSION -----

Version 2.0 of At Ease doesn't have this problem. Upgrade to At Ease 2.0. This problem has been confirmed in all versions of At Ease 1.x

If you use At Ease in conjunction with a file server, consider At Ease for WorkGroups, which will offer much more flexibility. There's no upgrade from 1.x to At Ease for Workgroups.
