TOPIC -----

This article provides a brief description of Catalog Services in Apple Open Collaborative Environment (AOCE).

DISCUSSION -----

One possible use of catalog services is a directory service of electronic mail addresses. However, PowerTalk catalogs can provide much more information than simple lists of names. Through either the PowerShare Catalog Server or through Catalog Service Access Modules, PowerTalk users can access data in any format from text to sound to images. Catalog services go far beyond simple lists of names.

PowerTalk provides a new icon on the desktop, the Catalogs icon, through which users can browse a variety of catalog services.

In addition, users can place personal catalogs on their local workstation. Personal catalogs can be placed in the Apple menu or in any other location on a local or shared drive.
