660AV and 840AV: Remote Launch Crashes (11/93)

TOPIC -----

I'm having trouble launching applications from a remote server with the 660AV and 840AV computers. In both cases, the computers crash, sometimes with a Bus Error, other times with a freeze, or Errors of Type 1, 2, and 3 when launching applications.

The 660AV is connected via LocalTalk and the 840AV is connected via TokenTalk to a Novell Server.

In both cases, setting the Cache Control Panel to More Compatible enabled the machines to operate properly.

Is there an incompatibility of this sort when launching applications or files on an AV computer from a remote volume?

DISCUSSION -----

Apple Support tested with a Centris 660AV and a Quadra 840AV and verified that some applications will crash or hang these computers when launched remotely with LocalTalk.

Launch of the application locally, or turn the cache OFF as a workaround for this problem.

The Novell situation is the same in that it is a remote launch of an application, and the same workarounds will work for it.
