Whenever I start my Macintosh, it asks me to log onto another drive on the network, and I can hit cancel 50 times before it goes away.

I don't think this is related to an AppleShare File Server or File Share, under System 7, set to open at system startup, because I've checked those. What could be causing this?

DISCUSSION -----

If throwing the AppleShare Prep file in the Trash doesn't solve the problem, you should check to see if Suitcase is installed. It has a feature which allows a user to connect to another users hard disk which has Suitcase installed. You can either move Suitcase out of your System Folder, or remove the reference to the remote disk in Suitcase.
