Macintosh Color Display, Quadra 605 and Energy Saver software

TOPIC -----

The Macintosh Color Display is listed as being Energy Star compliant but the Energy Saver software is telling me that the monitor is not compatible when installed on a Quadra 605. Is the software being revised to support this monitor? Should this configuration work with the Energy Saver software?

DISCUSSION -----

The Quadra 605, Macintosh Color Display, and the Energy Saver Display software (version 1.0), are compatible.

For this configuration to function properly you must be using system software version 7.1 and have at least 2MB of system memory available. Also, ensure that you are not using the CPU Energy Saver software (version 1.0.1) which is not designed to control the display. You must also use the Custom Install button even though there is only one item to select in the Custom Install list.
