Revised: 3/16/94 Security: Everyone CD300i Plus: Removing Stuck CD-ROM (3/94) _____ Article Created: 16 March 1994 TOPIC -----I have a CD-ROM installed in my CD300i Plus drive, but I don't have an icon for it on the desktop and the tray will not open when the Open/Close button is pushed. How do I remove a stuck CD-ROM? DISCUSSION ------WARNING: Turn off your computer before you attempt to eject the tray using a paper clip. If you don't turn off the computer, you may damage the CD-ROM drive. 1) Turn off your computer 2) Locate the small pinhole to the lower right of the CD-ROM tray opening. 3) Insert the end of a large straightened paper clip firmly and horizontally into the pinhole. 4) Push gently until the tray is released, then carefully pull the tray open. Do not force the tray open; wait until the paper clip has dislodged it or you may break the front of the tray.
