Our customer would like to know what the maximum tolerance, in milligauss, of the 14" RGB and 16" RGB monitors. We need to learn what is causing an interference pattern and determine a way around it.

It seems that there is some sort of magnetic field problem in his building causing monitor problems.

DISCUSSION -----

At this time, the display industry only recognizes emission standards related to the amount of emissions generated by a display. There is no standard that stipulates the amount of EMI a display can withstand and still continue to operate normally. Therefore, we do not test for this and cannot provide the information requested.
