TOPIC -----

I'm experiencing a problem with my Apple Workgroup Server (AWS) 95 and Retrospect where the date gets changed to the year 2017. Is there any known workaround until this problem is really fixed?

DISCUSSION -----

This problem is fixed with Tune-up 2.0, and we recommend installing it.

You may also try the following:

- 1) Reset the system clock (General cp will work for this).
- 2) Delete Retrospect scripts and rebuild them. You may need to delete the entire Retrospect folder (/mac/sys/System Folder/Preferences /Retrospect). The problem is not with Retrospect, but if Retrospect runs subsequent to the date shift, the script files are tainted by the wrong date.
- 3) You may want to resave any files with 2017 dates. Retrospect still backs them up, but the date information is still disconcerting in the Finder.
