TOPIC -----

What frame type is used by Macintosh computers interacting with a Novell Netware server using AppleTalk?

DISCUSSION -----

Novell Netware servers support four different frame types for Ethernet cards. These frame types and their associated protocols are as follows:

Begin\_Table

Frame Type	Protocols
-----	-----
EtherNet_802.2	IPX/SPX, and FTAM
Ethernet_802.3	IPX/SPX
Ethernet_II	IPX/SPX, TCP/IP, and AppleTalk Phase I
Ethernet_SNAP	IPX/SPX, TCP/IP, and AppleTalk Phase II

Except in rare cases where AppleTalk Phase I is still in use, Netware administrators will want to bind Ethernet\_SNAP to the server's Ethernet card servicing Macintosh clients.
